Often we hear the term "nurses eat their young" as a way of describing registered nurse lack of respect, caring and support in interactions with their colleagues, a concept also known as horizontal violence. The notion of vertical violence, which promotes power and superiority, has also been viewed as a major contributor of registered nurse job dissatisfaction and workforce stress. However, we also know that researchers, educators, scholars, nurse leaders and registered nurses working in the practice setting are creating environments where mentoring and caring relationships are valued and making a difference. We welcome manuscripts that are focused on nurse to nurse caring from either a theoretical, research or practice perspective.
