Why should I invest in attending the Summer Academy?

The Summer Academy is an opportunity to position yourself as one of the future leaders in caring science research. Creative brainstorming will help you develop ideas to move forward with practical implementation of your caring science research.

Five essential questions will open discussions and stimulate thoughtful dialogue:

1. What is the science of caring?
2. What are current exemplars of the science of caring research?
3. What could be the future of the science of caring research?
4. How do you integrate caring and the science of caring into research proposals for funders and others and build the science?
5. How do you move forward with the art of the possible?

What will I "take away" from this experience?

During your attendance at the 2016 Academy, you will:

- a. Clarify your own research agenda.
- b. Advance your skills and abilities as a future leader in caring science research.
- c. Take away the language to engage funders and others in a vision of caring science research in nursing.
- d. Co-create possibilities for the development of caring science research.
- e. An extensive bibliography based on caring science perspectives.
- f. Access to the evolving Tree of Caring Knowledge, a meta-resource for caring knowledge.
- g. Receive continuing education contact hours.

Faculty are experienced teachers and researchers who are dedicated to the study and advancement of caring science and caring science research. These include Drs. What is the cost of the Academy? What is included in the cost?

The cost is \$600 and fee includes: an intensive 2-day learning experience, breakfast and lunch for both days, an extensive bibliography focused on caring science, continuing education contact hours, and a structure for follow up mentoring/networking if desired.

Will continuing education contact hours be offered?
