A. Lynne Wagner Student Award

SCHOLARSHIP TO PROMOTE STUDENT PARTICIPATION AT THE ANNUAL IAHC CONFERENCE

Lynne Wagner Student Award is offered to encourage student participation at the Annual IAHC Conference and to enhance understanding of caring in nursing practice, education, and research. An award of \$500.00 is offered to help support student expenses for conference participation. Conference registration fee is also waived.

Purpose of the Award

The purpose of this award is to provide financial support to a student of nursing enrolled in an accredited college or university, pursuing a Baccalaureate or Masters Degree, to attend the Annual IAHC Conference and to enhance understanding of caring in nursing practice, education, and research.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must be a nursing student enrolled in an accredited college or university pursuing a Baccalaureate or Masters Degree.

Process and Expectations

The student submits an Application Packet with the following contents:

- A two-page paper describing how attendance at the conference will enhance understanding of caring science in nursing.
- A separate cover page with 1) Applicant's name, 2) Contact information (address, phone number, and email), 3) College/university where student is enrolled.
- A reference letter from a faculty member who knows his/her work.
- Submit Application to the IAHC Scholarship & Award Committee @ scholarships@humancaring.org.
