Purpose of the Award

• The purpose of this award is to provide financial support to a student of nursing to attend the Annual IAHC Conference.

Eligibility Criteria

 Applicants must be a student enrolled in an accredited college, or university pursuing a Baccalaureate, Masters or Doctorate Degree.

Process and Expectations

- The student submits an Application Packet with the following contents:
- A two-page paper describing how attendance at the conference will enhance understanding of caring science in nursing.
- A separate cover page with 1. Applicant's name. 2. Contact information (address, phone number, and email). 3. College/university where student is enrolled.
- A reference letter from a faculty member who knows his/her work.
- Submit Application to the IAHC Scholarship & Award Committee @ scholarships@humancaring.org).

Post Award Responsibilities

- At presentations or in publications, funded research and scholarly works should indicate that it is "Funded in part by the IAHC Justin Goldin Student Award."
